Admission for M.Phil. Programme 2011-12

## Guidelines as per UGC notification 2009

### (a) Eligibility

A candidate holding the Master's degree in relevant subject from any recognized university with at least 55% marks is eligible for entrance test for M.Phil. (relaxation of 5% for SC/ST and physically handicapped candidates).

### (b) Exemption from Entrance Test

1. Those who have qualified UGC/CSIR NET (JRF) examination (SET from Rajasthan only)/GATE (with a valid score) / Teacher Research Fellowship holder.
2. The students who qualify U.G.C. recognized J.R.F. test conducted by National /Govt. agencies such as ICSSR, ICPR etc.
3. A permanent University/College Teacher who is **appointed by RPSC**. In case of Teacher from an affiliated college the appointment must be approved by the University having a minimum five years teaching experience on regular basis.

The candidates belong to category 1 to 3 as above, would be exempted from the M.Phil. entrance test.

The entrance test will be conducted in the following subjects:

**Note:** Candidates are advised to appear in the subject of their post-graduation only. The seats available with University Departments & affiliated College.

**(c) Examination Fee and Mode of Payment**

Application form set for M.Phil. can be downloaded from university web site ([www.uok.ac.in](http://www.uok.ac.in)). The duly filled application form with a crossed D.D. of Rs. 1,000/- in the name of **Registrar, University of Kota, Kota** payable at **Kota** may be submitted to the office of the Convener (M.Phil. Programme), Near Kabir Circle, M.B.S. Road, University of Kota, Kota on or before 27.08.2011, Saturday, up to 3:00 p.m.

**(d) Scheme of Test**

The examination will be of two hours duration and the maximum marks of the test will be 100. There will be one paper consisting of two part, each part will be of 50 marks. For qualifying the test the candidate has to score minimum 40% marks in aggregate.

Part	Marks	Content
I	50	25 questions will be of general nature i.e. research aptitude and logical reasoning. The rest 25 questions will be from the subject concern. All 50 questions will be objective type multiple choice.
II	50	There will be 07 descriptive type questions. Out of these 03 questions will carry 10 marks each and 04 questions will carry 05 marks each. All questions would be from the syllabus of University of Kota, Kota PG course of the concern subject.

**Note:** The syllabus will be the same as those of University of Kota, Kota PG course of the concern subject 2011-12.

The test will be only for judging the eligibility of the candidate for M.Phil. programme. **Qualifying the eligibility test will not ensure that the candidate will necessarily be admitted for the M.Phil. course.**

**(e) Interview**

- (i) The candidates declared qualified in the entrance test and the candidates exempted from entrance test both would be invited for an interview to be conducted by the university. **The candidate would have to produce the original documents at the time of interview alongwith the attested copies of relevant mark sheets/ Certificates etc.** After the interview the admission would be given on the basis of merit.
- (ii) The number of students, who shall be admitted to the M.Phil. programme, shall be decided by the university as per the reservation policy of the State Government.

**(f) Course work**

The candidates are required to do course work soon after the admission for M.Phil. programme in view of UGC guidelines (2009).
